Sunset Strip
Londonderry Place
Price: \$15.495 million

With five bedrooms and 10 bathrooms over 7,000 sq ft, this contemporary house has all the mod cons. There is a club space with theatre, a lift, a six-car garage and floor-to-ceiling glass walls that are fitted with electronic shades.

The 3,500 sq ft rooftop, with decking and a bar, offers 180-degree views over the city. There are also fountains and a waterfall leading to an infinity pool.

bathrooms. It also has a flower-cutting room, a silver storage room, a barber shop, a massage parlour and a bowling alley in the basement.

BEST OF THE BUNCH
Sierra Alta Way
Price: \$18.850 million

This modern architectural showpiece is entered through a massive front pivot door, behind which hides a floating staircase.

The dining room has a 21ft motorised wine rack, and there is a car gallery with room for seven. All five bedrooms have walk-in closets and private balconies – the master bedroom's with a luxurious outdoor shower – and there is a zero edge pool in the garden.

Holmby Hills
Delfern Drive
Price: \$79 million

It is famously where Elizabeth Taylor fled after her first break-up with Richard Burton. Built in 1938, the house has 11 bedrooms and 16 bathrooms.

This manor was once the home of William Goetz, a founder of 20th Century Fox, and his wife Edie, daughter of the MGM co-founder LB Mayer.

The Beverly House is the former estate of media mogul William Randolph Hearst and was used as a filming location for *The Godfather* and *The Bodyguard*. It has an 82ft entry hall, a two-storey library and 19 bedrooms.

There are also two swimming pools and about five acres of land in total.
